# Equipping Ourselves for Prayer

Our church's theme for this year is "Wake Up! The King is Coming." The Bible teaches us that when the Lord Jesus returns, He will judge the world. We must all stand in front of Him and receive whatever we deserve according to what we have done in this earthly body. Living in the end time, Peter reminds us, "The end of all things is at hand; therefore, be self-controlled and sober-minded for the sake of your prayers." (1Peter 4:7, ESV)

This verse emphasizes that we must be self-controlled and sober-minded so that we can pray. In other words, sober-mindedness and self-control will lead to prayer. These attitudes equip us for prayer!

Self-control means self-discipline. It means correct living. It is the opposite of self-indulgence in our desires and greedy ambitions. Our lives should not strive after desires lest we eventually commit sin and dissipate.


The meaning of sober mindedness is like self-control. It is to maintain an alert mental state and clear-headedness. It is contrary to getting drunk and losing control. In the last days, people will deny God and reject the truth; therefore, we need to keep a clear mind so that we can know right from wrong and discern the will of God. We can identify the temptations from Satan and not fall into his trap. It also helps us not conform to this world's behavior and customs.


Being self-controlled and clear-minded is a lifestyle that will keep us from acting strangely and absurdly. It enables us to see this world from God's perspective and to obtain His guidance. This helps us to pray effectively and appropriately and to stand guard while we are looking forward to His second coming.

Prayer therefore should not be just presenting a list of prayer requests to God. The purpose of prayer is not a way to satisfy our desires or fulfill our ambitions. And it should be the result of our alertness and deliberation.


Being self-controlled and sober-minded are the requirements for prayer!
